Killeen ISD 2017 District and Campus Scores

The Killeen Independent School District has received district and campus scores for the 2016-2017 school year. As a district, Killeen ISD met the state standard on all four indexes and will receive a rating of *Met Standard*. All forty-eight campuses, once again, will receive a rating of *Met Standard*.

In 2017, the state redesigned all tests in grades 3-8, the English I EOC, and the English II EOC. In addition, STAAR A and STAAR L test versions were eliminated and replaced with STAAR (online) with designated supports. Particularly, campuses showed significant growth in Index 4 - Postsecondary Readiness.

“We remain very proud of our teachers, staff and students for their hard work and significant achievements. While the academic accountability system is merely one of the many indicators we utilize to measure success; affirmation of the tremendous efforts on the part of our employees, students, and community is to be applauded.
